When submitting a work to the NHCTE for publication in the NHCTE newsletter and/or on its website www.nhcte.org, it is the author's responsibility to complete and return this consent to publish form to the editor. It is also the author's responsibility to obtain express written and informed consent from anyone who has been quoted in the article.

Should a work submitted for publication contain more than 500 words from a published source, it is the author's responsibility to obtain express written permission to reprint from the copyright holder (usually the publisher or original author).

Authors, please copy/paste the following information to the bottom of your submission. Doing so will indicate your compliance with NHCTE consent to publish guidelines.

In submitting my original work and copying/pasting this to the bottom of the work, I verify that the work I have submitted to the NHCTE for publication in the NHCTE newsletter and/or on its website www.nhcte.org is original and that I have obtained express written and informed consent from anyone who has been quoted in the article.

I further verify that no more than 500 words in the work I have submitted for publication by the NHCTE are from a published source without my first obtaining express written permission to reprint from the copyright holder.
